# Welcome to Rooms 1, 2, 3 and 4 Junior school Before School Expectations

#### Students will

- -Take their shoes off when coming inside and leave them under their bags.
- -Hang up their school bag on their hook.
- -Put their book bag into the container.
- -Can choose to play inside or outside before the learning bell.
- Your help to remind them about these routines would be greatly appreciated.

# Clothing

- -Please insure that your child's clothing is named.
- -The expectation is that when students take something off, they put it in their school bag.
- -It is also expected that students have a change of clothes and a bag to put them into at school.
- Gumboots are not to be worn in Term 1 or Term 4.

## Library

# Rainy days

- -If it is raining at playtime or lunchtime, children eat inside.
- -All classes are supervised by Room 5 students and a roaming duty teacher.

# Literacy

- -We deliver a structured literacy program where reading and writing groups are taken at least four days a week.
- -Literacy homework will be recorded in their home journal.
- -Please ensure homework journals are returned each day along with any literary work.

# Numeracy

- Students in our classes will work in groups. These will begin once assessments are complete.
- Number continues as a major focus. Please encourage plenty of regular practise of number recognition so they are instantly recalled.
- This year the Junior Team will be using Numicon and the new Mathematics Curriculum.

#### PB4L

-We are a Positive Behaviour For Learning School. Positive behaviour and learning is recognised and rewarded with Dojo points and playground slips.

# Teacher Release Program

-This is taught in Room 9/MPR Room. All classes will have turns being taught an integrated curriculum lead by Mrs Coyle.

# Health and Physical Education

- -Term 1: Swimming- Please ensure your child has their togs and towel in a waterproof bag everyday.
- -Terms 1 to 4 please ensure your child wears/brings suitable clothes for physical activities and training.
- -As physical activities are part of the school curriculum, a note is required if your child is unable to take part.
- -Tissues and hand sanitiser are available in classrooms and your child is very welcome to bring their own to use as well.

#### School lunches
